## ***Participation in the Conference***

The submitted information will be stored in VNLU registration database and may be used and updated to register for the next events organized by VNLU. If you have previously registered on the web resource, please log into your personal account, select the conference and event to participate in and download the report materials. In case of changes in personal data, enter the necessary information in the «**Personal data management**» section.

The deadline for manuscript submission to **scientific secretaries of sections, round tables, seminars for inclusion in the conference proceedings (electronic edition)** is **August 3, 2026**. The proceedings of the International scientific conference will be assigned a digital object identifier (DOI).

**Deadline for registering** participants on VNLU webportal is **September 20, 2026**.

**Only those materials that fully comply with the conference topic and are of scientific and applied significance, have not been previously published will be considered.**

### ***Requirements for scientific reports:***

- **length – up to 5 pages,**
- **abstract (up to 500 characters including spaces),**
- **keywords and main text (3–8 pages),**
- **reference list is not included.**

Manuscripts are submitted in their entirety, are not reviewed, are not returned, and are not additionally edited. The authors are responsible for the reliability of the presented material, the correctness of citations of scientific sources and references to them, the accuracy of the facts, statistical data, the correctness of the conclusions, the correspondence of the translation of the text into a foreign language and other information. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make the final selection of

reports with the possibility of sending them to another event within the framework of the VNLU conference.

**Texts that do not meet the requirements and are sent after the deadline for consideration will not be accepted.**

The Organizing Committee of the Conference ensures compliance with the principles of academic integrity and has the right to refuse the author from publishing the material if the text reveals: plagiarism, self-plagiarism, compilation, excessive citation without proper analysis of sources of information. In case of rejection of submitted materials, the author will be notified by the scientific secretary of the conference event by e-mail within 10 working days from the date of registration.

The *StrikePlagiarism.com* system is used to check for plagiarism, in particular the module for detecting texts prepared by artificial intelligence.

By submitting abstracts to the conference, the author agrees to the publication of the text and metadata of the abstracts (including the author's last name, first name and patronymic, place of work, position, ORCID, email address for correspondence) in the electronic version of the collection of abstracts of reports, which, in accordance with the order of the Presidium of the NAS of Ukraine dated June 13, 2024 No. 352, provides for compliance with the open access policy under the Creative Commons license of the Creative Commons type CC BY-NC-ND 4.0 (<https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nc-nd/4.0/legalcode.uk>), which provides the opportunity to freely read, download, copy and distribute the content of the abstracts with indication of authorship, for educational and scientific purposes (non-commercial in nature) and without the right to create derivatives.

### **Abstract Formatting Requirements**

1. Length of abstracts – **up to 5 pages of A4 format** (297x210 mm); orientation – portrait; file format – Microsoft Word, version no older than 6.0; margins – 20 mm; font (typeface) – Times New Roman; size – 14; line spacing – 1.5; paragraph indentation – 1.25 mm, style – Normal (regular); **pages must be without numbering; do not use forced line breaks and extra spaces.**

2. Structure of the abstract and formatting parameters consist of the following main components:
